1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of
2 approximately 6.5 acres of land into fire district 40, known
3 as Bristow Annexation, for the purpose of providing fire
4 suppression and emergency medical services.

5 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 6 1. Fire district 40 accepted petitions requesting annexation of
7 approximately 6.5 acres of land into fire district 40, known as Bristow
8 Annexation, for the purpose of providing fire suppression and emergency
9 medical services in Resolution No. 506, adopted on June 12, 2014.
- 10 2. Pursuant to the state Environmental Policy Act, fire district 40 made a
11 determination of nonsignificance on the proposed annexation in
12 Resolution 506, adopted on June 12, 2014.
- 13 3. The King County Assessor issued a certificate annexation petition of
14 the signatures on the petition under the provisions of RCW 35A.01.040 on
15 June 11, 2014.
- 16 4. The Washington state Boundary Review Board has completed the
17 required evaluation of the proposed annexation and found the proposed
18 annexation to meet the necessary requirements.

19 5. The board of fire commissioners has exercised its right under RCW
20 52.04.011(3) to dispense with an election and to proceed directly to
21 annexation.

22 6. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of the annexation area
23 was filed with the county council on January 29, 2015.

24 7. RCW 52.04.011(2) requires the county council to determine whether
25 and the extent to which the annexation area shall be subject to the existing
26 indebtedness of the district. The petition indicates that the petitioners
27 agree to accept the financial obligation of voter approved general
28 obligation bonds issued by the fire protection district in 2005 and 2006.

29 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

30 SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 6.5 acres of land into fire district
31 40, known as Bristow Annexation, for the purpose of providing fire suppression and
32 emergency medical services described in Attachment A to this ordinance, is approved.
33 Approval of this proposed annexation is consistent with chapter 52.04 RCW.

34 SECTION 2. Fire district 40 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed
35 to be annexed.

36 SECTION 3. The county council finds that the property owners of the
37 annexation area are obligated to assume responsibility for any preexisting
38 finances or indebtedness issued by the district in 2005 and 2006.

39 SECTION 4. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval

40 or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service
41 to this annexation area.
