On page 1, beginning on line 6, strike everything through page 2, line 13, and insert:

"BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. This ordinance makes a supplemental appropriation of \$28,000,000 6 to the cultural development authority and \$500,000 to the historic preservation program 7 for the building for culture program. 8 SECTION 2. Ordinance 17941, Section 74, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows: 9 10 CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY - From the arts and cultural 11 development fund there is hereby appropriated to: 12 \$((29,401,000)) 57,401,000 Cultural development authority 13 **P1 PROVIDED THAT:** 14 Of this appropriation, \$2,000,000 shall be expended or encumbered solely for the 15 preservation action fund. Of that amount, funds shall not be expended or encumbered

16 <u>until the executive transmits an agreement between the county and 4culture on how the</u>

17 preservation action fund will be administered and governed and a motion that approves

18	the agreement, and the motion is passed by the council. The motion shall reference the
19	subject matter, the proviso's ordinance, ordinance section and proviso number in both the
20	title and body of the motion. The executive must file the motion required by this proviso
21	by February 1, 2016, in the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with the clerk
22	of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all
23	councilmembers, the council chief of staff, the policy staff director and the lead staff for
24	the budget and fiscal management committee, or its successor.
25	SECTION 3. Ordinance 17941, Section 92, as amended, is hereby amended to
26	read as follows:
27	HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROGRAM - From the arts and cultural
28	development fund there is hereby appropriated to:
29	Historic preservation program $((968,000))$ <u>1,468,000</u>
30	P1 PROVIDED THAT:
31	A. Of this appropriation, \$500,000 shall be expended or encumbered solely for
32	the Barn Again program to stabilize, rehabilitate and restore historic barns, farmhouses
33	and related outbuildings such as sheds, silos, milkhouses or other structures that are
34	historically associated with the working life of a farm or rural community. The grant
35	program will be managed by King County's department of natural resources and parks
36	historic preservation program. The department of natural resources and parks historic
37	preservation program shall solicit grant applications and determine the grant recipients
38	and grant awards, which are anticipated to be in the range of \$5,000 to \$75,000 based on
39	the following evaluation criteria:
40	1. The extent to which the project preserves historic character;

41	2. The readiness of the applicant to initiate, manage, and complete the project;
42	3. The reasonableness of the project cost estimate;
43	4. The extent to which the project will facilitate the building's long-term
44	preservation and continued use; and
45	5. The urgency of the threat and need for repair.
46	B. The executive shall transmit an annual report on this restoration program
47	identifying all applicants, amounts requested and awarded, the address and council
48	district of each project, descriptions of the restoration work for each barn or farm
49	structure and the estimated or actual completion date for each restoration project. The
50	executive shall transmit the annual report by February 1 each year, with the final report
51	being transmitted by February 1 of the last year the department of natural resources and
52	parks historic preservation program awards any funds to any applicants for the barn
53	restoration program. The executive must file the annual report in the form of a paper
54	original and an electronic copy with the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original
55	and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff, the
56	council policy staff director, and the lead staff for the transportation, economy and
57	environment committee or its successor."
58	
59	EFFECT: Restricts \$500,000 for Barn Again, a historic restoration program for barns
60	and other farm structures. Specifies that program will be administered and managed by
61	King County DNRP Historic Preservation Program. Provides eligibility, evaluation
62	criteria and reporting requirements for the historic restoration program.
