| 26 | consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities |
| 27 | technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and system |
| 28 | operations and has found: |
| 29 | a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the |
| 30 | Puget Sound Regional Council; |
| 31 | b. The district's service area includes portions of unincorporated King |
| 32 | County; |
| 33 | c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and |
| 34 | service needs; |
| 35 | d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality |
| 36 | laws; and |
| 37 | e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and |
| 38 | policies. |
| 39 | 6. Washington state Department of Health approval is pending upon King |
| 40 | County's approval of the plan. |
| 41 | 7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the district completed an |
