3	STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
4	1. King County has adopted K	.C.C. chapter 13.24, which requires
5	approval of comprehensive pla	ns for water and sewer utilities that provide
6	service in unincorporated King	County as a prerequisite for operating in
7	unincorporated King County, r	eceiving approval for annexation proposals,
8	being granted right-of-way fram	nchises, and being given approval for right-
9	of-way construction permits. I	K.C.C. chapter 13.24 prescribes the
10	requirements for approval of the	ose plans, including consistency with state
11	and local planning requirement	S.
12	2. The city of Bellevue's last g	eneral water facility plan was prepared in
13	2008. Washington state Depar	tment of Health and King County
14	regulations require water system	m plans to be updated every six years or
15	sooner if necessary.	
16	3. The city has a service area v	vithin unincorporated King County and has
17	adopted a water system plan up	odate ("the plan").
18	4. King County has adopted a	Comprehensive Plan that includes policies
19	F-101 through F-254, the appli	cable portions of which address water

20	policies for facilities and services; these water policies call for consistency
21	with other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water conservation
22	and protection of water resources.
23	5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
24	to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and
25	council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and
26	consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities
27	technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and system
28	operations and has found:
29	a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
30	Puget Sound Regional Council;
31	b. The city's service area includes portions of unincorporated King
32	County;
33	c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
34	service needs;
35	d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
36	laws; and
37	e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
38	policies.
39	6. Washington state Department of Health approval is pending upon King
40	County's approval of the plan.
41	7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the city completed an
42	environmental check list and the city issued a determination of

43	nonsignificance for the plan approval on January 28, 2016. There were no
44	appeals.
45	8. The city's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
46	administrative and planning standards. As the city's operations, facilities
47	and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code and are
48	consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities
49	technical review committee has recommended approval of the plan.
50	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

51 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The City of Bellevue Water System Plan, Attachment A to this

52 ordinance, is hereby approved as a comprehensive water system plan.
