5	STATEMENT OF FACTS:		
6	1. Concurrent with the introdu	ction of this ordinance, the solid waste	
7	division of the department of n	atural resources and parks has requested	
8	approval by ordinance for the	executive to sign and implement an	
9	agreement with the city of Algorithm	ona relating to the construction of a new	
10	recycling and transfer station in	the city.	
11	2. If the agreement for the con	struction of a new recycling and transfer	
12	station in the city is approved u	under Ordinance xxxx (Proposed Ordinance	
13	2017-xxxx), then the county ar	d city desire to enter into a separate land	
14	transfer agreement for the trans	sfer of the existing transfer station property	
15	to the city in accordance with o	chapter 39.33 RCW, chapter 39.34 RCW	
16	and chapter 35A.21.210 RCW.		
17	3. The land transfer agreement	provides that once the new transfer station	
18	opens, the existing transfer stat	ion will close, the structures on the existing	
19	transfer station property will be	e demolished, the property will be cleaned,	

20	as necessary, to meet industrial clean-up standards and the county will
21	convey the existing transfer station property to the city. In exchange for
22	the existing transfer station property, the city agrees to change its
23	corporate boundary in accordance with chapter 35A.21.210 RCW to
24	include within it a segment of West Valley Highway S in the city that is
25	currently owned by the county. This will provide the city ownership of
26	the entire right of way of West Valley Highway S between 5th Avenue
27	South and 1st Avenue North and relieve the county of all maintenance and
28	ownership responsibilities regarding the county-owned segment.
29	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
30	SECTION 1. The agreement for land transfer relating to the new transfer station
31	with the city of Algona, substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, is

32	hereby approved, and the King County executive is authorized to sign and implement the		
33	agreement.
