1	A MOTION appointing Eric Beckman, who resides in
2	council district eight, to the remainder of a three-year term
3	on the Vashon Island ferry advisory committee.
4	WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides for the appointment of ferry advisory
5	committees to express to the management of Washington state ferries the views of local
6	community groups regarding the service provided by the state ferry system and any
7	problems being experienced within the area served by the ferry system, and
8	WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides for Vashon Island to have a ferry advisory
9	committee consisting of three members, and
10	WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides that at least one person appointed to the
11	Vashon Island ferry advisory committee shall be a representative of an established ferry
12	user group or of frequent users of the ferry system, and
13	WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides that each member of the Vashon Island
14	ferry advisory committee shall reside in the vicinity of the Vashon Island ferry terminal,
15	and
16	WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides that not more than two members of the
17	Vashon Island ferry advisory committee may be from the same political party at the time
18	of their appointment, and
19	WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides that the members of the Vashon Island

ferry advisory committee shall be appointed by the Vashon/Maury Island community 20 council to serve staggered four-year terms, and 21 WHEREAS, RCW 47.60.310 provides that if the Vashon/Maury Island 22 community council fails to appoint a qualified person to fill a vacancy on the Vashon 23 ferry advisory committee within ninety days after the vacancy occurs, the legislative 24 authority of King County, which is the King County council, shall appoint a qualified 25 26 person to fill the vacancy, and 27 WHEREAS, the Vashon/Maury Island community council is no longer operating and was administratively dissolved by the Washington secretary of state in September 28 29 2013, and WHEREAS, in 2016, upon the expiration of the terms of the members of the 30 Vashon Island ferry advisory committee, and in the absence of the Vashon/Maury Island 31 community council, the King County council appointed as members of the Vashon Island 32 ferry advisory committee the three people who had been most recently appointed by the 33 34 Vashon/Maury Island community council, and 35 WHEREAS, for the 2016 appointments to the Vashon Island ferry advisory committee, the King County council set staggered terms, with one each for two years, 36 three years and four years, with the first of those terms expiring on June 30, 2018 and the 37 38 second expiring on June 30, 2019, and WHEREAS, the King County council desires that the ferry advisory committee 39 provide opportunities for clear and collegial communication between community 40 members and staff of the Washington State Ferries, so as to ensure efficient and effective 41 42 ferry services to King County residents and businesses, and

WHEREAS, through Motion 15143, the King County council developed a	
process for appointments to the Vashon Island ferry advisory committee by convening a	
Vashon Island ferry advisory committee membership review group to provide notice of	
vacancies to the community, offer the opportunity for interested community members	
from Vashon/Maury Island to apply to serve and organize a structured review of	
applications that are received that considers the responsibilities of ferry advisory	
committee members, and	
WHEREAS, in considering applications to fill the unexpired term for the position	
that ends on June 30, 2019, the Vashon Island ferry advisory committee membership	
review group made recommendations to the King County council for the appointment	
that meet the requirements for membership on the Vashon Island ferry advisory	
that meet the requirements for membership on the Vashon Island ferry advisory committee described in RCW 47.60.310;
