1           A MOTION providing for the honorary designation as Eric  
2           Anderson Memorial Field for Petrovitsky Park Baseball  
3           Diamond Number 1, to commemorate the life of Eric  
4           Anderson, who was a mentor, leader and inspiration to the  
5           thousands of students whose lives he touched as Athletic  
6           Director at Kentridge High School.

7           WHEREAS, King County is home to many parks and recreation fields, and

8           WHEREAS, on occasion, the King County council has designated fields, parks  
9           and trails in honor of community members who have dedicated themselves to service to  
10          others, and

11          WHEREAS, Eric Anderson, who was born in 1960 and is survived by his wife  
12          Margy and their two children, Maria and Ian, was well known for his encouragement and  
13          geniality throughout the Fairwood Community, and

14          WHEREAS, Eric Anderson was born in Enumclaw and graduated from  
15          Enumclaw High School, and

16          WHEREAS, Eric Anderson began teaching in the Kent School District in 1985,  
17          after working in the Tonasket school district, coming to Kentridge High School in 1998  
18          and becoming athletic director in 2000, and

19          WHEREAS, during Eric Anderson's time at Kentridge High School, he also

20 served as the leadership teacher, focusing on mentoring students and athletes and helping  
21 them grow into positive and effective leaders in the community, and

22 WHEREAS, Eric Anderson also served as baseball commissioner of the North  
23 Puget Sound League, organizing and enthusiastically supporting baseball games,  
24 tournaments and events for sixteen schools, and

25 WHEREAS, Eric Anderson excelled at encouraging students in their academic  
26 and extracurricular endeavors, and was a beloved and compassionate leader and  
27 coworker, and

28 WHEREAS, more than one thousand people celebrated Eric Anderson's life at a  
29 student-organized candle light vigil in his honor, and

30 WHEREAS, Eric Anderson was known as "the face of Kentridge" and the  
31 students and faculty at Kentridge High School, as well as members of the surrounding,  
32 community will miss him dearly, and

33 WHEREAS, Eric Anderson also touched the lives of many in the Kent School  
34 District and the North and South Puget Sound Leagues, and

35 WHEREAS, the joy, laughter and love of sports exhibited at Petrovitsky Park  
36 mirrors that which Eric Anderson projected on an everyday basis, and

37 WHEREAS, Eric Anderson himself played baseball throughout his youth in  
38 Enumclaw, and

39 WHEREAS, naming a baseball field in his honor is truly befitting to memorialize  
40 this vital member of the community;

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

42 A. Baseball Diamond Number 1 in Petrovitsky Park is given the honorary

43 designation as Eric Anderson Memorial Field to commemorate the life of Eric Anderson,  
44 who was a mentor, leader and inspiration to the thousands of students whose lives he  
45 touched as Athletic Director at Kentridge High School.

46 B. The executive is requested to erect at least one sign by Baseball Diamond  
47 Number 1, noting the honorary designation as Eric Anderson Memorial Field.
