DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Issued With a 14-day comment period

Description of Proposal:

This threshold determination analyzes the environmental impacts associated with the following actions, which are so closely related to each other that they are in effect a single course of action:

- The adoption of the Highline School District's ("District") Capital Facilities Plan 2018-2023 by the Highline School District No. 401 for the purposes of planning for the facilities needs of the District; and
- The amendment of the Comprehensive Plans of King County and the cities of Burien, Des Moines, Kent, Normandy Park, SeaTac, and Tukwila to include the Highline School District's Capital Facilities Plan 2018 -2023 as part of the Capital Facilities Element of each jurisdiction's Comprehensive Plan.

Location of the Proposal:

The Highline School District No. 401 includes an area of approximately 43.8 square miles. Portions of unincorporated King County and the cities of Burien, Des Moines, Kent, Normandy Park, SeaTac, and Tukwila fall within the District's boundaries.

Lead Agency: Highline School District No. 401

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the proposal does not have a probable significant adverse environmental impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.20C.030 (2) (c). If the DNS is retained, it will be final after the expiration of the comment deadline.
