METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Petition for Formation of Public Hospital District No.5 and Proposed Ordinance 2019-0228 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council's Committee of the Whole, Room 1001, King County Counthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 17th day of June, 2019 at 1:30 p.m., to consider the Petition for Formation of Public Hospital District No. 5 and to consider the adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0228, establishing November 5, 2019, as the date of a special election on the question of creating a public hospital district on Vashon-Maury Island; establishing the boundary lines of the proposed public hospital district; and determining the number of commissioners of the proposed district and the manner of their election. Elections and Licensing Services: We, the undersigned qualified voters who are residents of the territory of a proposed public hospital district, do hereby respectfully petition the King County Council of King County, Washington, and represent as follows:

1. There is a present need to form a public

hospital district to be known as Public Hospi-tal District No. 5, King County, Washington (the "District"), and the pro-posed territory herein-after described should district to furnish health care facilities and servic-es to adequately provide for the residents of such area and others as soon

area and others as soon as reasonably possible.
The boundaries of the proposed District should encompass all lands of Vashon-Maury Island. The territory to be included in the proposed District in bound be included in the pro-posed District is bound-ed from the point on Vashon Heights at the Northeast corner of Gov-ernment Lot 1, Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 3 East W.M. by the meander line of the low water marks of Pu-get Sound, starting East. get Sound, starting East, thence South around ad-joining Maury Island, thence South around the Southern tip of Vashon Island, thence North to Island, thence North to the original point of be-ginning, following the meander line of low wa-ter mark of Puget Sound at all times, and including all docks, wharves, and residences attached to said islands, which may protrude beyond the low water meander line. The boundaries of the proposed District fol-low existing precinct boundaries and do not

boundaries and do not divide any voting pre-cinct, all as required by RCW 70.44.030. The proposed Dis-trict should be estab-lished with a Board of Commissioners com-posed of five commisposed of five commissioners all of whom should be elected as at-large positions as authorized by RCW 70.44.040.

Pursuant to the laws of the State of Washington, after notice, hearing and consideration by the King County Council, a proposition of the formation of the District should be submitted to the vot tion of the District should be submitted to the voters within the territory of the proposed District for their approval or rejection at an election to be called for that purpose and to be held therein on November 5, 2019, in conjunction with the state general election. At such election, five commissioners for the District should be elected pursuant to the proed pursuant to the pro-

ed pusuant to the pro-cedures specified in RCW 70.44.040. WHEREFORE, your un-dersigned petitioners ask that the King County Council:

1. Fix a date, time and place for a hearing on this petition, and that published notice be giv-

2. Upon such hearing being had, make and enter an order approving the petition, and establishing and defining the boundaries of the proposed District;
3. Adopt a resolution

3. Adopt a resolution submitting the question of whether or not to form the District to the voters within the territory of the proposed District at an election to be called and held therein on November 5, 2019, and further providing for the election of public hospital district commissioners; and transmit such resolution containing a proposition for the formation of the District and providing for the election of commissioners therefor to the Auditor of King County, Washington, so that the Auditor may proceed with such election in the manner provided by law; and

4. Do and perform such other acts as may be reasonable or necessary in connection with this petition and subsequent proceedings to comply with the laws governing the creation of a public hospital district and to form the proposed District.
