NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on the 12th day of June, 2019, at 10:30 AM, to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0165.

Proposed Ordinance 2019-0165 does the following:

Makes a determination of the sewer rate for the year 2020 that must be charged in order to meet the monetary requirements (administration, operating, and maintenance, repair and replacement costs) of the County's sewage disposal program. The proposed sewer rate for 2020 is \$45.33 per month per residential customer equivalent (RCE). This is the same as the 2019 rate.

per month per residential customer equivolen (RCE). This is the same as the 2019 received the capacity charge for sewer conscious occurring between and including January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2021. The capacity charge is the fee that is assessed against customers establishing new connections to ensure that those customers bear their equivalent several capacity charge is the fee that is assessed against customers bear their equivalent several capacity related sewage facilities necessary to serve them. The proposed capacity charge is \$64.50 per RCE per month for fifteen years. By comparison, the 2019 capacity charge is \$64.50 per RCE per month for fifteen years.

• Authorizes certain affordability provisions in the capacity charge for identified vulnerable populations, including broadening the existing low-income capacity charge reductions for affordable housing to apply to a wider range of housing types, and allowing qualifying low income homeowners, who are eligible for the state property tax exemption for senior residents and disabled persons, to defer poyment of the capacity charge from placement of a property lien for the balance owed.
