2	approximately 73 acres of land into the Covington Water
3	District for the purpose of providing water service.

6	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
7	1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of approximately 73
8	acres of land, known as the Anderson Acres annexation, into the
9	Covington Water District for the purpose of providing water service was
10	filed with the county council on November 17, 2005.
11	2. Covington Water District has found the petition for transfer to be
12	sufficient and has concurred with the proposed transfer in Resolution No.
- 13	3427, passed on October 5, 2005.
14	3. Covington Water District filed a Determination of Nonsignificance on
15	the proposed annexation dated June 22, 2005.
16	4. The utilities technical review committee recommended county council
17	approval of the proposed annexation.

18	5. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has
19	considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.
20	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
21	SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 73 acres of land into the
22	Covington Water District for the purpose of providing water service described in
23	Attachment A of this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed annexation is
24	consistent with RCW 57.02.040.
25	SECTION 2. Covington Water District is the appropriate entity to serve the area
26	proposed to be annexed.
