1	AN ORDINANCE relating to school impact fees; adopting
2	the Capital Facilities Plans of the Federal Way, Riverview,
3	Issaquah, Snoqualmie Valley, Lake Washington, Kent,
4	Northshore, Fife and Auburn school districts as
5	subelements of the capital facilities element of the King
6	County Comprehensive Plan for purposes of implementing
7	the school impact fee program; establishing school impact
8	fees to be collected by King County on behalf of the
9	districts; and amending Ordinance 10470, Section 2, as
10	amended, and K.C.C. 20.12.461, Ordinance 10472, Section
11	2, as amended, and K.C.C. 20.12.462, Ordinance 10633,

24	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
25	SECTION 1. Authority. This ordinance is adopted to implement King County
26	Comprehensive Plan policies, Washington State Growth Management Act and King
27	County Ordinance 10162, with respect to the Federal Way School District, Riverview
28	School District, Issaquah School District, Snoqualmie Valley School District, Lake
29	Washington School District, Kent School District, Northshore School District, Fife
30	School District and Auburn School District. This ordinance is necessary to address
31	identified impacts of development on the districts to protect the public health, safety and
32	welfare, and to implement King County's authority to impose school impact fees under
33	RCW 82.02.050 through 82.02.080.
34	SECTION 2. Ordinance 10470, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 20.12.461 are
35	each hereby amended to read as follows:
36	The Federal Way Public Schools ((2006)) 2007 Capital Facilities Plan, Building
37	for the Future, undated, which is included in Attachment A to ((Ordinance 15331)) this
38	ordinance and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the
39	capital facilities element of the King County Comprehensive Plan.
