7	WHEREAS, Motion 12367 adopted Priorities for People - The 2007 King County
8	Budget—October 2006 to inform the 2007 budget process, and
9	WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council-adopted 2007 budget
10	identified priorities for people that are designed to earn public trust, to enhance the
11	quality of life and to protect public health and safety, and
12	WHEREAS, the identified aspiration to earn public trust would require the
13	engagement of county citizens to aid in the development of countywide priorities for their
14	county government, and
15	WHEREAS, this priority for people will require public workshops and other
16	means of developing countywide priorities to report to the council and to serve as a

17	guideline for policy direction to the executive in preparing his proposed budget for 2008,
18	and
19	WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council wishes to secure a contract
20	with an independent consultant to conduct this citizen engagement process;
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
22	The chair of the metropolitan King County council is authorized to enter into a
23	contract, in an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars, with Elway Research,
24	Inc., and FLT Consulting, Inc., to conduct a citizen engagement process, including but
25	not limited to, public workshops to prioritize county services and preparation of a report

to the council on those identified priorities, which will serve as a guideline for development of a policy directive for the executive's proposed 2008 budget.
