1	AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of		
2	Lakeridge Drive South, File V-2574; Petitioners: Aaron		
3	Eugene Collier and Dorian Colleen Kensok.

5	STATEMENT OF FACTS:		
6	1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Lakeridge		
7	Drive South hereinafter described.		
8	2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies		
9	serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required		
10	within the vacation area.		
11	3. The department of transportation records indicates that King County		
12	has not been maintaining Lakeridge Drive South. The records indicate		
13	that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition.		
14	4. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the		
15	right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the		
16	public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax		
17	rolls.		

18	5. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with		
19	K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty		
20	percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way, which was		
21	determined from records of the department of assessments. King County		
22	is in receipt of \$17,553.81 from the petitioners.		
23	Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was		
24	held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 5th day of December		
25	2007.		
26	In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation the		
27	council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King		
28	County to grant said petition.		
29	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:		
30	SECTION 1. The council, on the effective date of this ordinance, hereby vacates		
31	and abandons that portion of Lakeridge Drive South as conveyed to King County by the		
32	recording of the Plat of Lakeridge Division No. 2, recorded in Volume 32 of Plats, Page		
33	37, records of King County, Washington as described below:		
34	That portion of the southerly twenty (20) feet of Lakeridge		
35	Drive South right-of-way, abutting and adjacent to the		
36	north line of Lot 1, Block 44, in the Plat of Lakeridge

DEPARTMENT'S REPORT:

The Department of Transportation's written report to the King County Hearing Examiner for Item No. V-2574 was received by the Examiner on November 16, 2007.

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PUBLIC HEARING:

After reviewing the Department's Report and examining available information on file with the petition, the Examiner conducted a public hearing on the subject as follows:

The hearing on Item No. V-2574 was opened by the Examiner on December 5, 2007, in the Hearing Examiner's Conference Room, 400 Yesler Way, Seattle, WA 98104 and was continued for administrative purposes, pending receipt of an affidavit of publication of notice of the date of the hearing. The affidavit of publication (exh. 23) was received December 10, 2007, and the hearing was then closed. NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$250.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) on or before **December 26, 2007**. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and six (6) copies of

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a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on or before **January 1, 2008**.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.
