Proposed No. 2019-0432.2 Sponsors Balducci AN ORDINANCE relating to the county property tax 1 levies for collection in 2020, and implementing RCW 2 84.55.120. 3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 4 SECTION 1. The council is under an obligation by charter to enact revenue 5 measures that support the budget appropriation ordinance by December 1, 2019, for the 6 2020 budget. This ordinance sets the amount of property tax to be collected for the 7 regular property tax levy, the transit levy, the road district levy, the conservation futures 8 levy, the emergency medical services levy and the marine levy. In accordance with 9 RCW 84.55.120, the council has given proper notice of this ordinance to the public. 10 SECTION 2. For collection of the property tax levies in 2020, the council hereby 11 authorizes property tax changes compared to the amounts authorized for collection in 12 2019 as follows: 13
