6	1. The	current city of Cov	ington corporate boun	dary at SE 272nd Street
7	coincide	es with the north rig	ght-of-way line of SE	272nd Street between the
8	east city	/ limit line of Covir	ngton and west city lin	nit line of Maple Valley.
9	2. The	city of Covington a	pproved ordinance nu	mber 05-08 to revise its
10	corporat	te boundary at SE 2	272nd Street to fully in	clude that segment of the
11	road rig	ht-of-way within th	e corporate limits of t	he city.
12	3. Rece	nt annexations to th	ne north and south of s	SE 272nd Street have
13	bisected	the street right-of-	way into two capital i	mprovement projects for
14	the city.			
15	3. The c	vity's planned right-	of-way improvements	s on SE 272nd Street
16	require a	additional right-of-v	way dedication on bot	h the north and south
17	sides of	the existing street.

18	4. The dedication of right-of-way will create confusion between city and
19	county agencies and residents as to ownership and responsibility for
20	maintenance and operations of the street.
21	5. It is in the city and King County's best interests to have the SE 272nd
22	Street right-of-way included within the corporate limits of the city of
23	Covington.
24	6. RCW 35A.21.210 authorizes "the governing bodies of a county and
25	any code city located therein may by agreement revise any part of the
26	corporate boundary of the city which coincides with the centerline, edge,
27	or any portion of a public street, road or highway right-of-way by
28	substituting therefore, a right-of-way line of the same public street, road or
29	highway so as fully to include or fully to exclude that segment of the
30	public street, road or highway from the corporate limits of the city."
31	7. Revision of the corporate boundary of a city is effective upon approval
32	by the city council and the county legislative authority as provided for in
33	RCW 35A.21.210.
34	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
35	SECTION 1. The revision of the corporate boundary of the city of Covington to
36	

- 37 include the segment of SE 272nd Street right-of-way, legally described as set forth in
- 38 Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved.

Legal Description for the Incorporation of Boundary Roads SE 272nd Street/SR – 516/Kent-Kangley Trunk Road/Charles M. Fouts Road to the City of Covington

Those portions of Sections of 29, 30, 31 and 32, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W. M., King County, Washington described as follows:

That portion of the SE 272^{nd} Street / SR – 516 / Kent-Kangley Trunk Road / Charles M. Fouts Road right-of-way abutting and adjacent to the South City Limits of the City of Covington, as defined by City of Covington Ordinance No. 78-03, between the East City Limits of Covington, as annexed by City of Covington Ordinance No. 10-05, and the West City Limits of Maple Valley, as defined by King County Ordinance No. 12456.
