1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the director of elections's  
2 compensation.

3  
4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. Director of elections's compensation. As of February 4, 2009,  
6 and annually thereafter, beginning January 1, 2010, the elected office of the director of  
7 elections shall be compensated at an annual rate of 78.5 percent of the authorized annual  
8 compensation of the King County executive as it may be adjusted from time to time.

9 SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect only if the proposed charter amendment  
10

11 to make the county director of elections a nonpartisan elected office is approved by a  
12 majority of voters at the November 4, 2008, election.




