On behalf of the nine bargaining units and 484 King County employees represented by the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, we would like to inform you of our support and intent to recommend ratification of the Tentative Agreement between King County and the King County Coalition of Unions Addressing the 2009 Budget Crisis. In fact, three of our bargaining units, Locals 1652, 1652-M and 2084-FM have already ratified the Agreement.

The remainder of the bargaining units will be holding ratification votes as soon as possible, pending completion of open collective bargaining agreements and/or implementation decisions by Superior and District Courts. We will continue to inform you when each of those units has ratified the Agreement.
