| 22 | A. King County is increasingly concerned that the future of the Lake Sammamish | | |
| 23 | Kokanee is being jeopardized by the alarming decline in their abundance, productivity, | | |
| 24 | diversity and distribution, significantly impairing their long-term viability; | | |
| 25 | B. King County commends the cities of Issaquah, Bellevue, Sammamish and | | |
| 26 | Redmond, the Snoqualmie Indian Tribe, Trout Unlimited, People for Puget Sound, Save | | |
| 27 | Lake Sammamish, Washington state Department of Fish and Wildlife, United States Fish | | |
| 28 | and Wildlife Service and many citizen volunteers for their leadership and collaboration in | | |
| 29 | the conservation of the Lake Sammamish Kokanee; | | |
| 30 | C. King County strongly encourages the United States Fish and Wildlife Service | | |
