Proposed No. 2009-0422.2 Sponsors Ferguson 1 A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters' 2 pamphlet statements for and against the charter amendment 3 placed on the ballot by Ordinance 16484 for the November 4 3, 2009, election. 5 6 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of local voters' pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for 7 8 annual general elections held in King County, and 9 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a unit of 10 local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of 11 that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating 12 voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter 13 rejection of the measure, and 14 WHEREAS, Ordinance 16484, passed by the council on April 27, 2009, provided for submission to the voters at the November 3, 2009, general election, of a proposed 15 16 amendment to Section 990 of the King County Charter and repeal of Section 350.20.30, 17 Section 900, Section 910, Section 920, Section 920.10, Section 920.10.10, Section
