7	local voters' pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for
8	annual general elections held in King County, and
9	WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a unit of
10	local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of
11	that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating
12	voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter
13	rejection of the measure, and
14	WHEREAS, Ordinance 16546, passed by the council on June 8, 2009, provided
15	for submission to the voters at the November 3, 2009, general election, of the proposed
16	repeal of Section 475 of the King County Charter;
