Dear Property Owner:

As you may know, a petition has been presented to the Metropolitan King County Council to change the name of 136<sup>th</sup> Place Southwest to Tabor Avenue Southwest. Because this street is located in unincorporated King County, the County Council is responsible for deciding whether or not to change the street name. If the Council approves the name change, the street address of your property on 136<sup>th</sup> Place SW will be changed.

Proposed Ordinance 2009-0456 would approve this street name change. As a first step in considering this proposed ordinance, the Council's Physical Environment Committee will review the ordinance on Tuesday, August 25, 2009. This meeting will take place starting at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers on the 10<sup>th</sup> Floor of the King County Courthouse at 516 Third Avenue in Seattle.

After the committee makes its recommendation, the legislation will be considered by the Council for public hearing and possible action. K.C.C. 16.08.020 requires that all affected property owners be given 20 days advance notice of the public hearing on a proposed street name change. This is your notice that on Tuesday, September 8, 2009, at 1:30 p.m., the Metropolitan King County Council will hold a public hearing on Proposed Ordinance 2009-0456 in the Council Chambers. After the public hearing, the Council may act on the proposed ordinance.

As an affected property owner, you can attend the September 8 public hearing to testify before the County Council. You may also submit your comments in writing to the following address:
