1	AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of
2	51st Avenue South, File V-2608; Petitioners: Dale Fite and
3	Lonnie Scott.

5	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
6	1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 51st
7	Avenue South hereinafter described.
8	2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies
9	serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required
10	within the vacation area.
11	3. The department of transportation records indicate that King County has
12	not been maintaining 51st Avenue South. The records indicate that no
13	public funds have been expended for its acquisition.
14	4. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the
15	right-of-way useless as part of the King County road system and believes
16	the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax
17	rolls.

18	5. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with
19	K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty
20	percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way, which was
21	determined from records of the department of assessments. King County
22	is in receipt of \$1,530.40 from the petitioners.
23	Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and hearings were
24	held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 20th day of May 2009
25	and the 8th day of July 2009.
26	In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation the
27	council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King
28	County to grant said petition.
29	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
30	SECTION 1. The King County council, on the effective date of this ordinance,
31	hereby vacates and abandons that portion of the 51st Avenue South right-of-way as
32	conveyed to King County by the recording of Plat of Jovita Heights recorded in Volume
33	20 of Plats, on page 12, records of King County, Washington as described below:
34	That portion of the west 4 feet of 51st Avenue South (dedicated as Illinois
35	Avenue) as conveyed to King County by the plat of Jovita Heights,
36	recorded in Volume 20 of Plats, on Page 12, records of King County,
37	Washington, abutting and adjacent to the east line of Lots 15 through 21,
38	of Block 62, of said Plat. Together with the east 4 feet of 51st Avenue
39	South (dedicated as Illinois Avenue) as conveyed to King County by said

plat, abu	tting and adjacent to the west line	of Lots 6 through 9, of Block	
61, in sa	id plat.

#### **DEPARTMENT'S REPORT:**

The Department of Transportation's written report to the Hearing Examiner for Petition No. V-2608 was received by the Examiner on April 23, 2009.

#### PUBLIC HEARING:

After reviewing the Department's Report and examining available information on file with the petition, the Examiner conducted a public hearing on the subject right-of-way as follows:

The hearing on Petition No. V-2608 was conducted by the Examiner on May 20, 2009, in the Hearing Examiner's Conference Room, 400 Yesler Way, Seattle, Washington 98104 and then reopened on July 8, 2009 to cure a public notice defect. The hearing was then continued administratively for receipt of the affidavit of re-publication. The affidavit was received on July 13, 2009, at which time the record closed. Participants at the public hearing and the exhibits offered and entered are listed in the attached minutes. A verbatim recording of the hearing is available in the office of the Hearing Examiner.

<u>FINDINGS</u>, <u>CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATION</u>: Having reviewed the record in this matter, the Examiner now makes and enters the following:

#### FINDINGS:

1. General Information:

- 2. Notice of hearing on the Department's report was given as required by law, and a hearing on the report was conducted by the Examiner on behalf of the Metropolitan King County Council.
- 3. Except as provided herein, the Examiner adopts and incorporates herein by this reference the facts set forth in the Department's report to the Examiner for the hearing and the statement of facts contained in Proposed Ordinance No. 2009-0227. The Department's report will be attached to those copies of this report and recommendation that are submitted to the County Council.
- 4. Maps showing the vicinity of the proposed vacation and the specific area to be vacated are in the hearing record as exhibit nos. 7 and 17.
- 5. The subject right-of-way segments, which are four (4) foot wide edge strips along the Petitioners' frontages, are not currently opened or maintained for public use.
- 6. Vacation of the right-of-way would have no adverse effect on the provision of access and fire and emergency services to the abutting properties and surrounding area.
- 7. The right-of-way is not necessary for the present or future public road system for travel or utilities purposes.

- 8. No easements are necessary to be retained for the construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services.
- 9. The compensation required by law to be paid as a condition precedent to vacation of this right-of-way has been deposited with King County.

#### CONCLUSION:

1. The right-of-way segments subject to this petition are not useful as part of the King County road system, and the public will be benefited by their vacation.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

APPROVE proposed Ordinance No. 2009-0227 to vacate the subject road right-of-way.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$250.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) on or before August 10, 2009. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and six copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on or before August 17, 2009.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, 516 Third Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within 21 days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.
