Proposed No. 2009-0573.2 Sponsors Gossett 1 AN ORDINANCE relating to county automotive parking 2 facilities; and amending Ordinance 12077, Section 18, as 3 amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.055. 4 5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 6 SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in fees for surface 7 parking lots and for other county parking facilities. 8 B. The service charges in section 2 of this ordinance are assessed under K.C.C. 9 2.99.030. 10 SECTION 2. Ordinance 12077, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.055 are 11 each hereby amended to read as follows: 12 A. Monthly employee and county vehicle rates for parking in the Goat Hill 13 parking garage, the Chinook Building, the King County Correctional Facility((5)) and 14 open surface parking lots that are designated by rule to be subject to parking charges 15 ((and bicycle lockers)), shall be as follows: 16 Reserved/Designated **Unreserved Area** 17 Area

24	B. The facilities management division of the department of executive services		
25	shall identify surface parking lots where it is reasonable and feasible to charge employees		
26	for monthly parking. These surface parking lots are located at county facilities outside		
27	the downtown Seattle metropolitan core and include, but are not limited to, district courts,		
28	health centers, alcohol treatment facilities, police precincts, youth service centers and		
29	similar facilities. Designation of open surface lots that are subject to parking charges		
30	shall occur by administrative rule adopted pursuant to K.C.C. 3.32.010.		
31	C. For county employees with disabilities that make it difficult or impossible to		
32	use public transit, and who display a disabled parking permit, the fee for covered parking		
33	shall be fifty percent of the normal rate rounding up to the next even dollar and applies to		
34	all King County facilities management division managed parking facilities. Employees		
35			

with disabilities shall receive first priority in the assignment of available parking stalls. 36 37 SECTION 3.
