

## Youth vapor product use increases

E-Cigarette use by grade level



## Flavors & youth use

- Over 7,000 flavors sweet fruit and candy
- 4 out of 5 kids who vape report vaping flavored products
- Flavors attract kids and lead to more puffs each time kids reach for device
- Youth using flavors were more likely to maintain vaping over the long term



# WA State policy response

#### 2016

- WA State enacts vapor product sales law that mirrors tobacco law
- Preempts local jurisdictions from enacting stronger regulations

#### 2019

- Age increased to 21
- WA State BOH adopted emergency rule banning the sale of flavored vapor products
- BOH flavor ban is only temporary (120 days)

# **Federal policy response**

- New national minimum age 21
  - FDA is now focusing enforcement only on cartridge/pod-based flavored products (except menthol)
- Leaves 7,000+ flavors on the market
  - Youth likely will switch to menthol (previously used mint)
  - Youth can easily refill closed cartridges with other flavors
