Title:	Community Development Block Grant Phase III

<p>Summary: The CARES Act provided \$5B in supplemental Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. HUD previously announced the first \$2B in CARES Act funding for CDBG grantees, including \$1.8M to King County, which is being used for rental assistance. This \$5,663,680 award is the County’s share of the third tranche of CDBG CARES Act funding, which focused funds toward places with households facing higher risk of eviction. These funds provide the County additional flexibility, waivers and alternative requirements in the use of these funds (except for requirements related to fair housing, nondiscrimination, labor standards, and the environment). As required by jurisdictional interlocal agreements, DCHS will work through the Joint Recommendations Committee to determine how the CDBG funds should be allocated.</p>
