1	Pg. 13, Line 294	Sheriff (BOWMAN)	Lambert	Adds \$400,000 of General Fund and restricts those moneys for the purpose of supporting a mental and behavioral health navigator program in unincorporated King County.	
2	Pg. 13, Line 294	Sheriff (BOWMAN)	Kohl-Welles	Adds \$150,000 of General Fund and restricts those moneys for the purpose of supporting emphasis patrols by Sheriff deputies around the perimeter of the King County Courthouse through June 2021.	
3	Page 17, Line 374	Drug Enforcement Forfeits (BOWMAN)	Dembowski	Decreases the maximum allowed FTEs in the Drug Enforcement Forfeits fund from 3.0 to 1.0 and restricts any additional revenues above \$500,000 for the purpose of supporting and expanding the Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) program related to controlled substances.	
4	Page 18, Line 388	Human Resources and Office of Labor Relations (LESKINEN)	Lambert	Adds \$25,000 to both the Department of Human Resources and the Office of Labor Relations and ask the Executive to transmit a report, jointly prepared by the Department of Human Resources and the Office of Labor Relations, examining the development of vacation and holiday schedule options in addition those currently utilized by the County.	
5	Page 33, Line 740	Adult and Juvenile Detention (CURRY)	Balducci	Add a proviso in the Adult and Juvenile Detention budget to require a report providing information on the department of adult and juvenile detention's community work program and alternative ways to serve the needs of program participants and provide direction for the study of options for reestablishing a Community Work Program either as an alternative to secure detention or for the mitigation of legal financial obligations, or both.
