6	STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
7	1. On October 6, 2008, the cour	ncil amended the transportation
8	concurrency program to improve	e the effectiveness and streamline its
9	operation by adopting a travel ti	me based concurrency map to be used for
10	both residential and nonresident	al development proposals.
11	2. K.C.C. 14.70.270 requires the	e concurrency map to be updated annually
12	and submitted to the council as p	art of the budget process.
13	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CO	OUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
14	SECTION 1. Ordinance 14050,	Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C. 14.70.230
15	are each hereby amended to read as follo	ows:
16	A. The department shall perform	a concurrency analysis and test for each travel
17	shed to determine whether areas within t	he travel sheds are concurrent. The test for each
18	area shall be based on the level of servic	e analysis results for the entire travel shed.

Areas shall be deemed concurrent if eighty-five percent of the arterials within their travel shed meet level of service standards.

B. The department shall use the concurrency map currently in effect when making a concurrency determination for a proposed development. The concurrency map displayed in Attachment A to ((Ordinance 16266)) this ordinance is adopted as the official concurrency map for King County. The department shall make a determination of concurrency according to the status indicated on the adopted concurrency map for the area in which the proposed development is located. Attachment B to Ordinance 16266 is a map indicating the boundaries of the travel sheds.

29 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Attachment A to Ordinance 16266, Transportation Concurrency

map, dated September 15, 2008, is hereby repealed.
