1. King County has adopted	King County Code ("K.C.C.") chapter 13.24,
which requires approval of	comprehensive plans for water utilities that
distribute or obtain water in	unincorporated King County as a prerequisite
for operating in unincorpora	ted King County, receiving approval for
annexation proposals, being	granted right-of-way franchises, and being
given approval for right-of-	vay construction permits. K.C.C. section
13.24.060 prescribes the req	uirements for approval of such plans,
including consistency with s	tate and local planning requirements.
2. The Revised Code of Wa	shington ("RCW") 57.16. 010 requires that
general comprehensive plan	s for water districts be submitted to, and
approved by, the legislative	authority within whose boundaries all or a
portion of the district lies.

20	4. The district is in King County and has adopted a 2006 water system
21	plan ("the plan").
22	5. King County has adopted a comprehensive plan that includes water
23	supply policies in its provisions for facilities and services (policies F-213
24	through F-245) that call for consistency with other adopted plans, support
25	for regional water supply planning, pursuit of reclaimed water, water
26	conservation, and protection of water resources.
27	6. K.C.C. 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
28	("UTRC") to review and make a recommendation to the King County
29	executive and council on the plan and the requirements under K.C.C.
30	13.24 and consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The
31	UTRC has reviewed the planning data and district operations and hereby
32	finds:
33	a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
34	Puget Sound Regional Council for the district's service area;
35	b. The plan uses King County land use classifications for the portion of
36	the district's service area located in unincorporated King County;
37	c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
38	service needs;
39	d. The plan is consistent with applicable state water quality laws,
10	including the evaluation of reclaimed water use; and
11 .	e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
12	policies.

43	7. The DOH approval of the district's plan is pending King County
44	council action.
45	8. The district completed a State Environmental Policy Act checklist and
46	re-issued a Determination of Nonsignificance for the issuance of the plan
47	on October 30, 2009.
48	9. The district's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
49	administrative and planning standards. As the district's operations,
50	facilities and planning meet the requirements of the K.C.C., and are
51	consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the UTRC
52	recommends approval of the plan.
