Description of request:

Invest in communities to sustain and expand innovations that have been key to meeting community food needs. DPH will contract with a non-profit organization to manage contracts with up to twenty community-based organizations (CBOs) to purchase, store, and distribute culturally appropriate foods. This program will focus on Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC)-led organizations.

Food insecurity has tripled in King County since March 2020. The populations most affected by food insecurity are those that experience health disparities and structural racism: African Americans, Latinx, immigrants and refugees (undocumented immigrants, in particular), transgender individuals, people with disabilities, and people who are experiencing homelessness. In response, CBOs, faithbased and cultural communities, and other newly formed grassroots groups began distributing culturally appropriate food to those most affected by health disparities and structural racism. These community agencies report a need for additional staff to distribute food; fresh produce and protein; drivers and vehicles to transport food; and more storage capacity.
