NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-28 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act or Tuesday, November 17, 2020, beginning at 1:00 PM. The purpose of this public tearing was to consider adoption of Priposed Ordinance 2020-0329 (Ordinance 19205), adopting the capital facilities plans of the Auburn, Enumclaw, Federal Way, Fife, Highline, Issaquah, Kent, Northshore, Lake Washington, Renton, Riverview, Snowalmie Valley and Tahama School Districts for purposes of implementing the school impact for porgam.

SUMMARY
The Washington State Growth Management Act (GMA) authorizes local jurisdictions to collect impact fees as a method of financing public facilities (i.e., roads, parks and open space, schools) that become necessary as a result of new growth and development.

King County administers the School Impact Fee Program by collecting fees from residential developers on behalf of each school listrict that chooses to participate (the program is voluntary). The fees are developed by the individual school districts in accordance with provisions in state law and King County Code and are set forth in the districts' capital facilities plans. The plans (and fees) are reviewed and adopted by the King County Cot nail.

Ordinance 1920; omends Title 20 to update the school capital facilities plans and Title 27 to implement the collection of impact fees by the county on behalf of the following school districts, effective January 1, 2021:
