7 "ER10 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

8 Of this appropriation, \$500,000 shall be expended or encumbered solely to
9 contract with the Andy Hill Cancer Research Endowment (CARE) Fund to address health
10 disparities in King County that have been exacerbated due to the COVID-19 pandemic
11 and to establish a more equitable workforce in the health care industry in King County.
12 The appropriation encumbered in this Expenditure Restriction ER10 shall also support a
13 report written by the Andy Hill Cancer Research Endowment (CARE) Fund, which shall
14 include, but not be limited to, findings, recommendations and next steps identified from
15 the work completed as a result of the contract. The report should be electronically filed
16 with the clerk of the council no later than July 31, 2022, who shall retain an electronic
17 copy and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff and
18 the lead staff for the community, health and housing services committee, or its

19 successor."
