

2021: Moving Beyond COVID-19

- Increasing open hours in 2022
- **Hiring** in progress
- Production technology for robust online programming
- Technology and assistance for patron remote activities from community libraries









Initial Pandemic Response

- KCLS sustained service throughout the pandemic
- Multiple mandates, including **limits to in-person contact**
- Pivot to online programs, materials and contactless curbside services
- Dramatic increase in cardholders to **1.1 million**
- **eBook use increased from 5M to 7.4M** in 2020, ranking KCLS second in the U.S. and third in the world for eBook downloads.



Ongoing Pandemic Response

- Vaccine clinics with
 Public Health Seattle &
 King County
- HVAC investments for increased fresh air flow
- Phased reopening of all libraries by July 2021
- Aggressive grant seeking to tackle problems exacerbated by COVID-19



Technology Innovations

- TeleConnect telemedicine partnership with Harborview Equipment and private space for online health and social service appointments
- Extended Wi-Fi at 45 library locations
- Hotspots and Digital Navigation assistance with 299 hot spots, 47 laptops
- Exterior Lockers with 24/7 access to library material holds







Grant Funding

• Meeting room technology upgrades and trained staff to support patron remote meetings and work

Online programming and public production room

• Enhanced **hybrid meeting room** for increased participation in KCLS Board meetings



Service Innovations

- **Invest In Yourself**: Economic justice, small business recovery
- Welcoming Enterprise connects BIPOC small business owners with resources to advance equitable local economies
- Welcoming Centers expansion celebrating Afghan arrivals
- Writers of Color literary programs for residents to see themselves represented
- Increasing opportunities for social interaction and lifelong learning among seniors/older adults







Partnerships

- Metro Via picks up riders at Skyway Library and connects to light rail and transit centers
- Department of Local Services support for **Reimagining Public Safety** community engagement
- KCEO & Chambers vaccine signage initiative
- King County Elections voter information and 23 library ballot boxes
- 577,000 student eCards



Climate Action

- Libraries as **cooling centers** during the worst heat on record
- KCLS Green Initiative
- Aligning **KCLS capital investments** with King County, state and federal climate action plans
- **Lowering emissions** of KCLS vehicles and buildings
