Ms. Patterson briefed the Council on the October 28th meeting of the Sound Transit Board. She indicated the Board debated the idea of reducing the amount Sound Transit invests into its art program, but voted to stay with 1% of the capital project construction costs. The Board also approved a resolution for full funding of the First Hill street car. It is expected to be completed by late 2013.

Ms. Patterson reported on the Special Board of Health meeting which was a budget workshop. The Board had a report on budget proposals coming from the county, the state and the City of Seattle. She indicated that over the last two years public health has had to cut its budget by 22 percent. The Board reviewed the potential impact from state budget cuts. The Board is hoping that the state legislature will reconsider cuts to public health.

Mr. Phillips reported on the Cedar River Council. Mr. Phillips indicated that the Council has been discussing preparations for floods from the Cedar River in the Maple Valley community.
