As a personal privilege, Ms. Hague acknowledged Mei Jui Lin, who has worked actively with King County on behalf of our sister county relationship with Kaohsiung. Mei Jui Lin introduced Dr. Ming-Ji Wu, Ph.D., Eisenhower Fellowship 2011 Fellow and Director General of the Department of Industrial Technology, Taiwan, who is visiting the United States.
