7. Proposed Ordinance No. 2017-0484

AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on April 24, 2018, of a proposition to support continuation of the regional automated fingerprint identification system, also known as AFIS, program by replacing authorization of an expiring property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a consecutive six-year period, at a first year rate of not more than 3.5 cents per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation for collection beginning in 2019, with subsequent maximum levy collections being increased by the limit factor defined in chapter 84.55 RCW, as amended, for the purpose of funding the continued operation of the regional automated fingerprint identification system program and related technology and services, which maintains expanded crime scene and arrest identification capabilities for all local criminal justice agencies in King County.

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Greg Doss and Samantha Porter, Council Staff, briefed the committee and answered questions from the members. Dwight Dively, Director, Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget, provided comments and answered questions from the members. Carol Gillespie, Director, Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS), also answered questions from the members.
