1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:34 p.m.

2. Roll Call

3. Approval of Minutes of April 23, 2018

Boardmember Upthegrove moved to approve the minutes of the April 23, 2018, meeting as presented. Seeing no objection, the Chair so ordered.

4. Approval of Invoices

Michelle Clark, Executive Director, reported on the following invoices: Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD)(March 2018 operating \$846,479.40; capital \$4,017,993.30), Lund Consulting (\$15,250.00), ESA (\$3,971.25) overpayment due to discrepancy in invoice. John Taylor, Assistant Division Director, Water and Land Resources Division, updated the Board on the Willowmoor project and five upcoming flood damage repair projects: the Tolt, Snoqualmie, Sammamish and Green River, and SE 19th Way. He also announced that 2017 was the largest year to date for capital expenditures.
