AN ORDINANCE authorizing a new funding agreement and amendment to the existing financing agreement with the Washington State Major League Baseball Stadium Public Facilities District.

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Andrew Kim, Council staff, and Jeff Muhm, Council Initiatives Director, briefed the Committee and answered questions from the members. April Putney, Director of Government Relations, Office of the Executive; Fred Rivera, Executive Vice President and General Counsel, Seattle Mariners; and Patrick Hamacher, Acting Chief Policy Officer, King County Council; answered questions from the members.
