Boardmember McDermott read a statement from Dr. Jeff Sperring, CEO, Seattle Children's Hospital.

Boardmember Delecki offered a verbal amendment, after line 16, insert, "WHEREAS, Seattle Children's Hospital announced on January 15, 2021 the convening of an independent, external assessment of Seattle Children's race, equity, inclusion and diversity policies and practices, and".

Boardmember Kohl-Welles a verbal amendment to the amendment, after 'WHEREAS', insert "following extensive community outcry," The motion carried.

Boardmember Delecki offered a verbal amendment on line 20, after 'endorses', insert "the". The motion carried.

Boardmember Zahilay offered a verbal amendment to strike on line 22, "expects healthcare organizations in King County to prioritize actions that" and insert on line 22, after 'stakeholders', "The King County Board of Health calls on Seattle Children's Hospital and all health care organizations in King County to". The motion carried.

Boardmember Mosqueda offered a verbal amendment on line 22, after 'stakeholders', insert "The King County Board of Health calls on Seattle Children's Hospital to engage the community in the investigation." The motion carried.

Boardmember Zahilay offered a verbal amendment on line 22, adding after 'investigation.', insert "King County Board of Health calls on Seattle Children's Hospital to lift restrictions associated with non-disclosure agreements to facilitate the investigations recommended in this Resolution". The motion carried.

Boardmember Zan, offered a verbal amendment, on line 24, strike 'institutional and interpersonal forms of racism in' and insert "racism in all its forms within". The motion carried.
