The committee's recommendations were adopted unanimously. Ms. Patterson stated that the committee is made up of city, county, port, environmental and business leaders from the entire four county region. The recommendations will go before the Executive Board at the next meeting.

Mr. von Reichbauer commented on the recent Legislative Steering Committee meeting and reviewing major legislation that affects King County. He indicated there are 980 measures introduced in the Senate and 1,151 in the House.

He reminded the members of the upcoming March 6th External Affairs Committee which will meet in Olympia with a hosted lunch following, which will give legislators and members of the Council an opportunity to get together.
