#### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:42 p.m.

#### 1. Approval of Minutes of February 12, 2007

*Ms.* Hague moved to approve the minutes of the February 12, 2007 meeting as presented. Seeing no objection, the Chair so ordered.

#### 2. <u>Reports on Special and Outside Committees</u>

*Ms.* Patterson reported on the February 15, 2007 Board of Health meeting. The Board was briefed on food labeling. The Board is interested in making policy decisions in reducing obesity in King County. The Board adopted its 2007 work program, which focuses on the public health operational master plan, healthy eating and active living initiatives, and public health financing. The Board, in a joint meeting with the Law, Justice and Human Services Committee approved the public health operational master plan policy framework. In conjunction with the Law, Justice and Human Services Committee and the City of Seattle Council's Housing, Human Services and Health Committee, the Board confirmed the new Public Health Director, Dr. David W. Fleming.

*Mr.* Phillips gave a brief update on WRIA 8. He indicated that the plan that had been approved and developed for salmon recovery in the Cedar, Lake Washington and Lake Sammamish systems was drafted by the Steering Committee and now approved by a body of elected officials. Within WRIA 8 there are 27 different jurisdictions. Mr. Phillips stated that WRIA 8 is organized for implementation of the plan.
