1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:54 p.m. The meeting was recessed at 2:50 p.m. The Chair reconvened the meeting at 3:36 p.m.

Mr. von Reichbauer read and presented the recognition to Chan Ho Kwon, Consul General of the Republic of Korea. Mr. Kwon thanked the council and introduced members of the Korean community in attendance.

6. Reports on Special and Outside Committees

Ms. Lambert reported on Board of Health. The Board approved the work programs for three new committees that will focus on special aspects of public health. The committees are Injury Prevention, Obesity Prevention and Provision of Services. The Seattle City Council and King County each contributed \$150,000 from their consecutive 2008 budgets to fund an enhanced HIV Program. The Board received a legislative update on the status of menu labeling legislation and was briefed on a video program developed by Public Health, entitled Business Not as Usual, which discusses preparing for the Pandemic Flu.

Mr. Phillips briefed the Council on Sound Transit. The Board discussed where they are on their oversight efforts for Sound Transit. The initial segment is 87% complete and in on schedule to open in July 2009. The Rainier Valley segment is 97% complete along Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Mr. Phillips stated that the community outreach effort for businesses along Martin Luther King Jr. Way was very successful and they are starting to thrive again.
