4. Approval of Minutes of January 26, 2009

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Mr. Ferguson moved to approve the minutes of the January 26, 2009 meeting as presented. Seeing no objection, the Chair so ordered.

5. <u>Reports on Special and Outside Committees</u>

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Ms. Lambert reported on her attendance at the conference of the National Association of Counties. The participants shared their best practices and Ms. Lambert indicated that King County was far ahead, especially with jail entry and with people that are dealing with mental illness and drug abuse. The participants had a briefing on homeland security and Ms. Lambert expressed that the resources were very valuable. Mr. Constantine reported on the Sound Transit Operations Task Force. The members discussed Sound Transit's future regarding bus fleet and the mix of vehicles that will be required to provide for future transit needs. There was discussion regarding articulated buses in the fleet. The Operations Task Force will be making recommendations to the Executive Director of Sound Transit by May. The Executive Director will present the recommendations to the Board by June.

Mr. Phillips briefed the Council on the Sound Transit's Central Link Oversight Committee. He stated that the initial segment from downtown Seattle to Tukwila will be open in July, and that 31 of the 35 light rail cars have been conditionally accepted to run on the tracks. Mr. Phillips gave a progress report on the construction of light rail. The next meeting will be on February 19.

Mr. Constantine reported on the Sound Transit Board. He indicated that at the meeting, the Somali Youth and Community Services Group was presented with a certificate recognizing its outstanding efforts last September with the Rainier Valley Safety Street Fair. The Board approved the purchase of its first installment on expanding its bus fleet to provide additional bus service. The Board also received a report from the Citizens Oversight Committee regarding the cost environment in which Sound Transit is operating.
