4. Proposed Ordinance No. 2009-0325

AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting the collective bargaining agreement negotiated by and between King County and International Federation of Professional & Technical Engineers, Local 17 (Office of Emergency Management, Project/Program Manager III) representing employees in the department of executive services; and establishing the effective date of said agreement.

5. Proposed Ordinance No. 2009-0245

Mr. Ferguson and Mr. Phillips

AN ORDINANCE proposing an amendment to Section 880 of the King County Charter, addition of a new Section 897 to the King County Charter and addition of a new Charter Appendix A to the King County Charter, to restrict the county from conveying or converting uses of specified county-owned, high conservation value properties except by an amendment of the charter; and submitting the same to the voters of the county for their ratification or rejection at the November 2009 general election.

Chair Ferguson offered opening remarks regarding the proposed ordinance 2009-0245. Ingrid Lundin, Project Program Manager, Department of Natural Resources and Parks (DNRP), briefed the committee and answered questions from the members on 14 properties proposed by the Executive for protection under the Open Space Amendment. Rebecha Cusack, Council Staff answered questions from the members.
