AN ORDINANCE establishing a new King County mental illness and drug dependency oversight committee; amending the King County Code to be consistent with Chapter 157, Laws of Washington 2008; amending Ordinance 15949, Section 4, and K.C.C. 4.33.020 and Ordinance 15949, Section 5, and 4.33.030 and adding a new chapter to K.C.C. Title 2.

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$490,000 to records and licensing and \$80,000 to public health that is revenue backed from the animal benefit bequests/donations account and an \$80,000 current expense fund transfer to public health and a \$130,000 appropriation to the building repair and replacement fund and a \$130,000 disappropriation in the major maintenance fund in support of the immediate operational and capital improvements to King County animal care and control; and amending the 2008 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 15975, Sections 30, 47, 93, 130 and 134, as amended, and Attachments B and F, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

Marilyn Cope and Polly St. John, Council Staff, briefed and answered questions of the Committee regarding proposed ordinance 2008-0224 making a supplemental to the King County Animal Control.
