NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to accept the approximate 0.16-acre land donation valued at seventy-eight thousand dollars from Kenneth L. Peterson, consistent with the King County Real Estate Donation Agreement provided as Attachment A to this motion for King County conservation and flood risk reduction purposes. The open space acquisition unit within the water and land resources division of the department of natural resources and parks is responsible for handling the technical real estate transaction and administrative matters associated with this donation, including the closing and recording of the deed and is authorized to execute such other documents as are necessary to complete the transaction.
