



2. The watercraft would be returned to the dealer at the end of the loan period; and

3. The county would pay for the maintenance of the watercraft and any damage other than ordinary wear and tear, and

WHEREAS, there has been a significant positive public service impact with the use of the watercraft, and

WHEREAS, local dealers participating in the nationally recognized law enforcement loaner programs are willing to loan the county two personal watercraft in one-year increments, under the same conditions that have applied since 1996;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to accept the loan of two personal watercraft from any nationally recognized law enforcement loaner program each year, in one-year

increments, to be used exclusively by the King County sheriff's office for public safety purposes.
