SECTION 1. The Memorandum of Agreement negotiated by and between King County and the Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17, representing employees in the Department of King County Information Technology and the Department of Executive Services, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.
