



that exceed fifty thousand dollars require acceptance on behalf of King County by the King County council by motion, and

WHEREAS, all gifts to the King County parks and recreation division in the department of natural resources and parks are used only for park purposes, and

WHEREAS, the donor, Max Prinsen, is a land owner who would like to make the donation to King County so that the land is preserved for generations to come;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to accept two conservation easement donations that together equal approximately twenty-three and one-half acres valued at one hundred sixty-seven thousand five hundred dollars from Max Prinsen, consistent with the King County Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreements, which are Attachments A and B to this motion, for King County parks and recreation division purposes. The open space acquisition unit within the water and land resources division of the department of natural resources and parks is responsible for handling the technical real estate transaction and administrative matters associated with this donation, including the closing and recording of the easement, and is authorized to execute such other documents as are necessary to complete the transaction.
