



WHEREAS, the water and land resources division of the department of natural resources and the road services division of the department of transportation have worked together with a consultant to conduct an inventory and business risk assessment of the drainage trunk system within major road rights-of-way in unincorporated King County, and

WHEREAS, the inventory report provides information on the location and condition of the drainage trunk system within major road rights-of-way in unincorporated King County, estimates accuracy of the resultant database, analyzes data to assess risks of failure and failure impacts, and includes a prioritized program for maintenance that contains a replacement schedule and costs, and

WHEREAS, the executive has transmitted to the council the requested report and motion;
